One to judge, one to each scorer, one to opposing advisor. Four copies of yellow Defense nomination sheet. One to judge, one to each scorer, one to opposing advisor. Note that in the Semi-final and Final Rounds there are three and four scorers respectively. You will need additional blues and yellows. Bailiff and clerk notes and checklist. Timesheets.
	For the competition or for yourself. Exhibits for Prosecution. Notepad or notebook to take notes. No cell phone or smart phone used by any one in the courtroom.
